Welcome to Stowmarket Swimming Club. The club can trace its history back to 1888 when swimmers used the River Rattlesden (also known locally as the River Rat), later moving to a long-removed open-air pool in Combs Ford before making Mid-Suffolk Leisure Centre its home in 1986. As such, you will be a member of a club that has been an important part of the modern community for thirty years and part of the town's history for over 125 years.

It is important to remember that while we have a professional head coach everyone else associated with the club are unpaid volunteers. Club members and their families need to ensure they do all they can to help with the smooth running of the club, particularly by making sure fees are paid correctly and on time and that you keep up to date with the club's announcements.

The following guidance has been written for the benefit of parents and guardians of child swimmers although there are elements such as the code of conduct and guidance to competition that should be read by older swimmers. Whilst accurate at the time of being issued all this guidance is subject to change from time to time.

Similarly, if the swimmer is <u>under</u> 18 years old the Parent/Guardian CoC (on the reverse) is to be signed by at least one parent or guardian. Once signed they should be returned to the club with the other copy retained.

- Fees: Squad and Coaching Guidance.

- Swimmer Absences as a result of Injury and Illness.
- Guide to Competition: Preparation and At the Gala.
- Volunteering.
- Becoming an Official.
